TOWNSHIP MEETING DATE - September 29, 2015

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXCHANGE OF EASEMENT INTERESTS ON  
BLOCK 88, LOT 3.05 IN THE TOWNSHIP OF FREEHOLD, MONMOUTH COUNTY,  
NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, there currently exists a landscape easement on  
Block 88, Lot 3.05 which was conveyed to the Township of  
Freehold in 2002 (hereafter "Existing Landscape Easement"); and

WHEREAS, a portion of a retaining wall was installed within  
the Existing Landscape Easement; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Existing Landscape  
Easement to be reconfigured so that the portion of the retaining  
wall is not located within a landscape easement; and

WHEREAS, in order to accomplish the reconfiguration of the  
Existing Landscape Easement, the property owners will convey to  
the Township a new landscape easement area, and the Township  
will convey to the property owners its interest in the Existing  
Landscape Easement where the portion of the retaining wall is  
located; and

WHEREAS, the new landscape easement area which the Township  
will receive is described in attached Schedule A; and

WHEREAS, the portion of the Existing Landscape Easement containing the retaining wall that will be relinquished by the Township is described in attached Schedule B; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:12-16 allows a municipality to exchange property interests when it is in the public interest to do so; and

WHEREAS, the Township Tax Assessor has evaluated the easements pursuant to the direction contained in N.J.S.A. 40A:12-16 and has concluded that the new easement area the Township will be receiving and the Existing Landscape Easement area the Township will be relinquishing are of equal value.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Freehold as follows:

1. The value of the new easement area the Township will be receiving is equal to the Existing Landscape Easement area it is relinquishing based upon the evaluation of the Tax Assessor pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-16.

2. The Mayor and Township Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a Deed relinquishing the portion of the Existing Landscape Easement.

3. The Township Attorney is hereby authorized to take any and all action reasonable and necessary in order to conclude the exchange of easements as described herein.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Freehold that this Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication according to law.

**EXPLANATORY STATEMENT:**

This Ordinance authorizes the exchange of landscape easement interests on Block 88, Lot 3.05.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Township of Freehold desires to further the public interest by obtaining a Grant from the State of New Jersey in the amount of approximately \$3,000.00 to fund the following: Green Communities Grant - Community Forestry Management Plan; and,

WHEREAS, Freehold Township's Grant Identifier Number is FS16-105 and the prior Resolution acknowledging eligibility is R-15-56;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Township of Freehold that Thomas L.
