Freehold Township Recreation Summer Camp registration packets are available on line at www.twp.freehold.nj.us or in the Recreation Office.

Payment and **completed** registration packet must be received by the Recreation Office no later than 4:00 p.m. on the day of the deadline to receive the discounted fee. Applications received after 4:00 p.m. will be marked with the following day's date.

Registrations received via the mail will be marked on the date the Recreation Office receives the completed packet. The Recreation Office is not responsible for any applications lost in the mail.

Registrations received with incomplete information - including medical information - will not be processed or marked as "received" until all forms are completed. First time campers must include a copy of their birth certificate with their completed packet.

Freehold Township Recreation Summer Camp will be accepting 300 "business-resident" campers into the program. These campers will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. To qualify, a parent must be employed by a Freehold Township business and verify this employment with two pay stubs dated after February 1, 2011. Busing is not available to "business-residents."

Skate Park participants must have a Freehold Township Parks and Recreation Skate Park photo ID card.

Skate Park users are required to turn their cards into the Skate Park Attendant when they access the facility. Cards will be returned to the individual upon leaving the skating facility.

Card processing is available at the Recreation Office weekdays between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. and requires a parents to sign for any participant under the age of 18.
