TEDROW HOUSE, 121 THREE BROOKS ROAD – Property should have been removed from Historic Resources Report based on minutes from meeting of January 8, 1990 because of technical irregularities in the process. HPC has no jurisdiction in the matter of the sale of the house. Two other properties in the Report need to be removed as well. C. Cook will review.
