MEETING OF APRIL 18, 2022

NEW BUSINESS: Discussed June 3 seminar in Trenton and who signed up. AGC beginning to repair Georgia Rd. schoolhouse porch. Repair of riser, and sanding and sealing of the porch surface. Detached area on side to be repaired. And will follow up with gazebo repair at Oakley, repair window on woodshed. Total cost to the Heritage Society \$5275.00

HERITAGE SOCIETY: Two events impending. April 30, May 1 is Weekend at Old Monmouth. Car show and bake sale/yard sale at Oakley to coincide. House tours will be provided.
