### First Grade Lavender

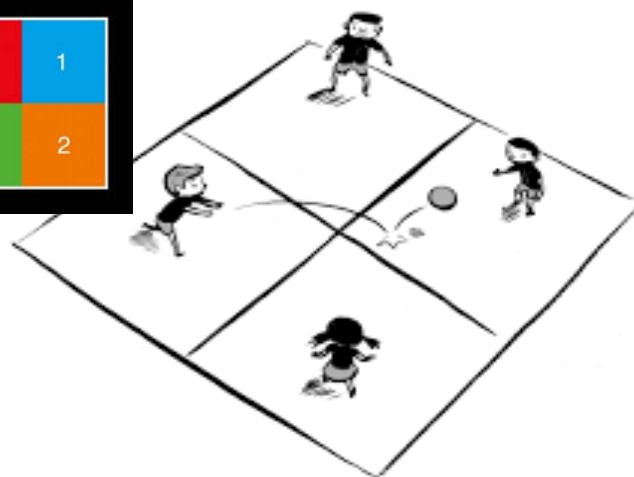
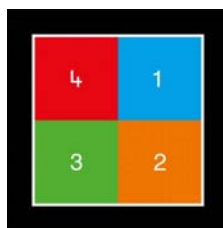
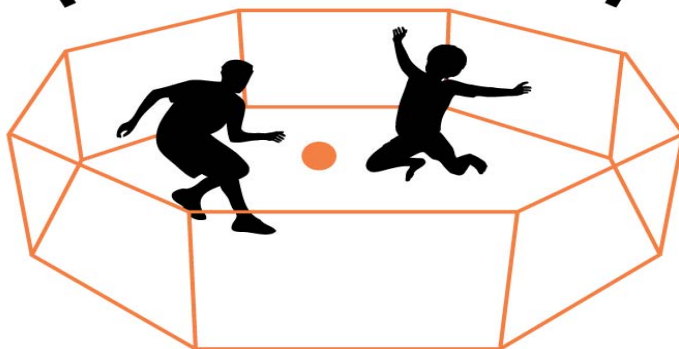
