First Grade Orange

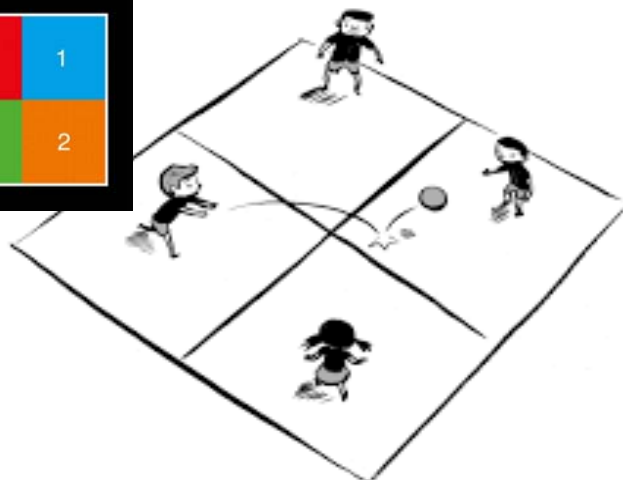
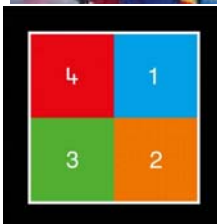
What a great first week! Please label all belongings including sunscreen and also dress your campers in their bathing suit.

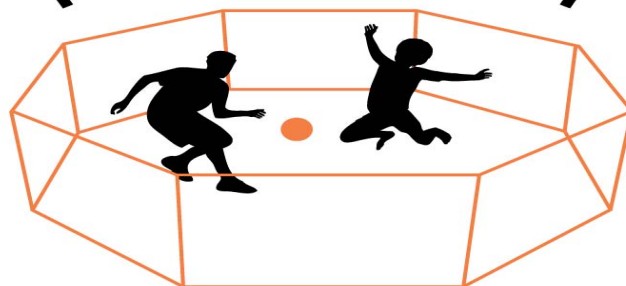
Sixth Grade Red
