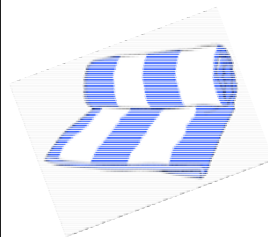
Avoid a Tragedy
